Twenty-four children between the ages of 2 and 5 were screened for early vision disorders with a special camera called an MTI Photoscreener. This system is proven effective because it can detect problems that very young or non-verbal children cannot express. Lion Lisa will receive the results of the screening soon, and will share them with the club.

Birthdays will be celebrated at the March 3 meeting.

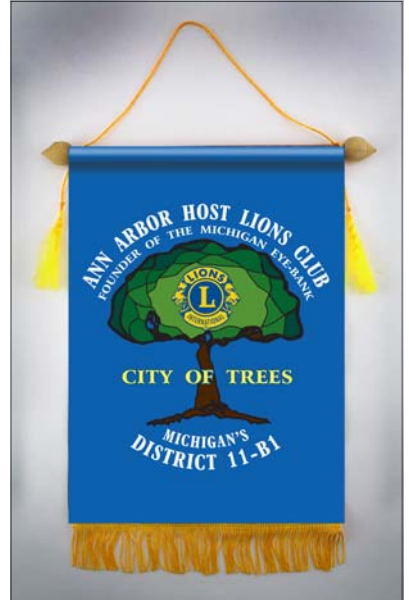
VOLUNTEERS NEEDED
